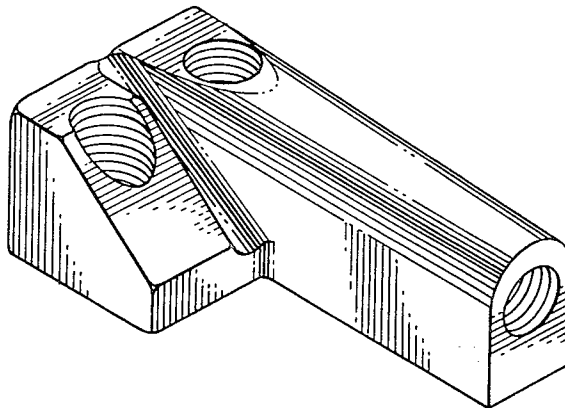

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bridge saddle for guitars, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a bridge saddle for guitars showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 7 is a front elevational view.



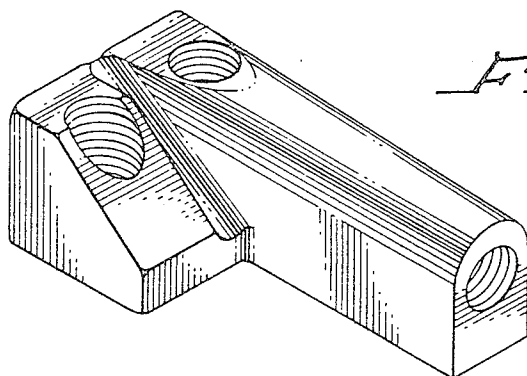

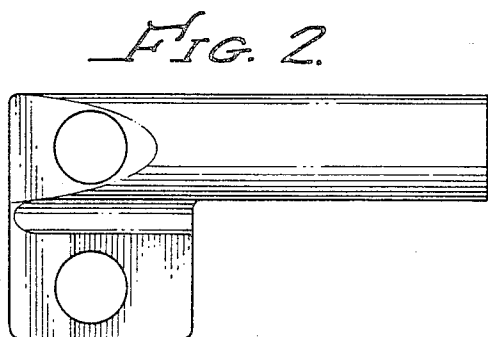

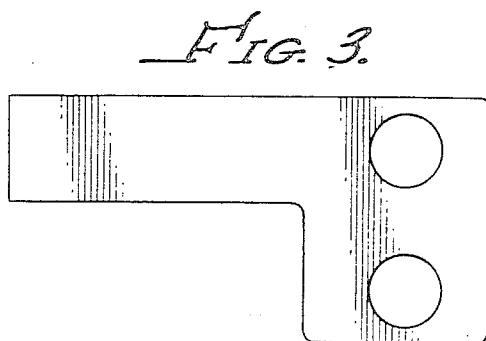

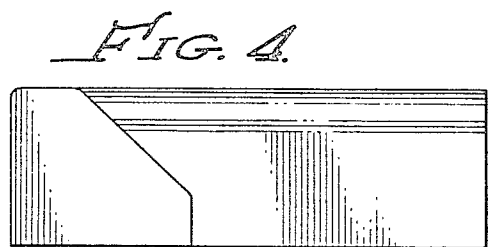

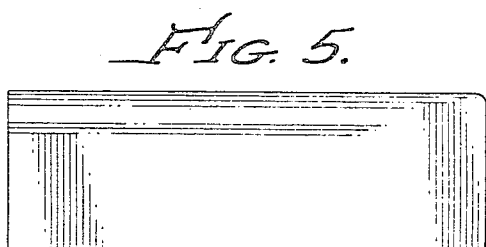

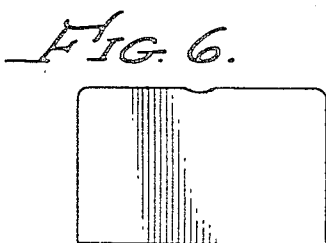

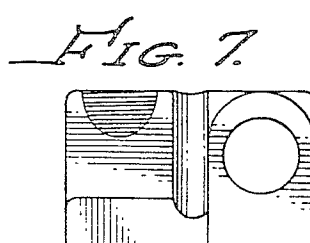
