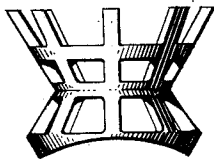

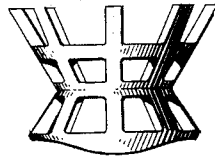
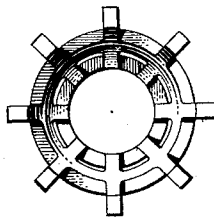

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, ALFRED SPANEY and JOSHUA W. MAYER, citizens of the United States, residing, respectively, at Piermont, Rockland county, in the State of New York, and at the city of New York, borough of Manhattan, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jewel-Setting, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—
