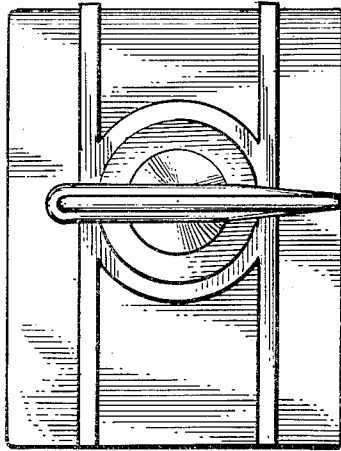

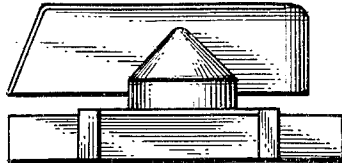
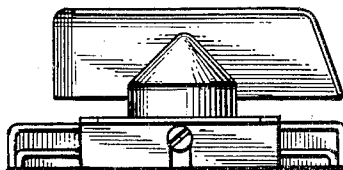

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert J. Seator, a citizen of the United States and resident of Battle Creek, in the county of Calhoun and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Furnace Damper Regulators, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan or face view of a furnace damper regulator showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an end view of the upper end shown in Fig. 1.

Fig. 3 is an end view of the lower end of the new design as shown in Fig. 1.
