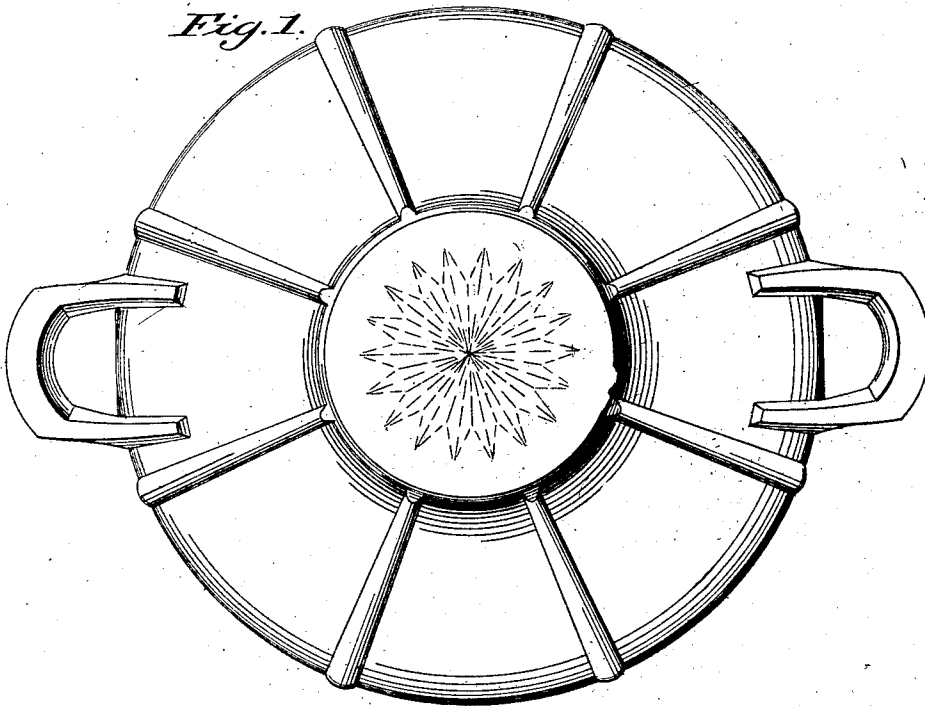

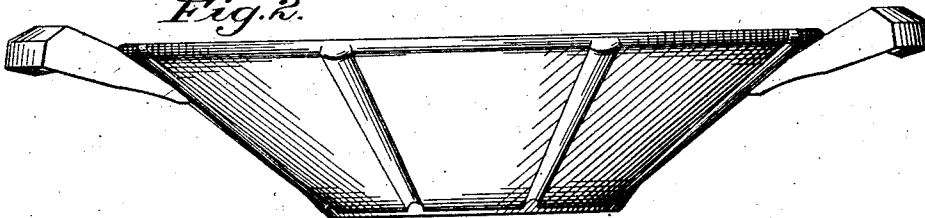
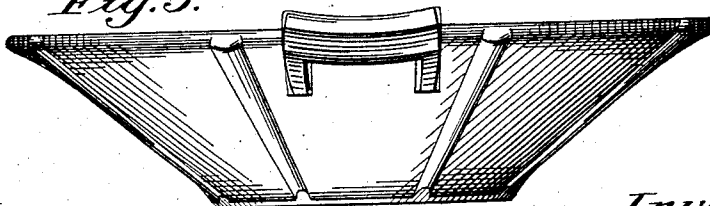

DESIGN FOR A DISH.

Application filed March 20, 1923. Serial No. 5,546. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, T. CLARENCE HEISEY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newark, in the county of Licking and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dish, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a bottom plan view of a dish in which the design of my invention is physically embodied.

Figure 2 is a view in side elevation of the dish.

Figure 3 is a view also in side elevation, looking at the dish from a position at right angles to the line of vision of Figure 2.
