

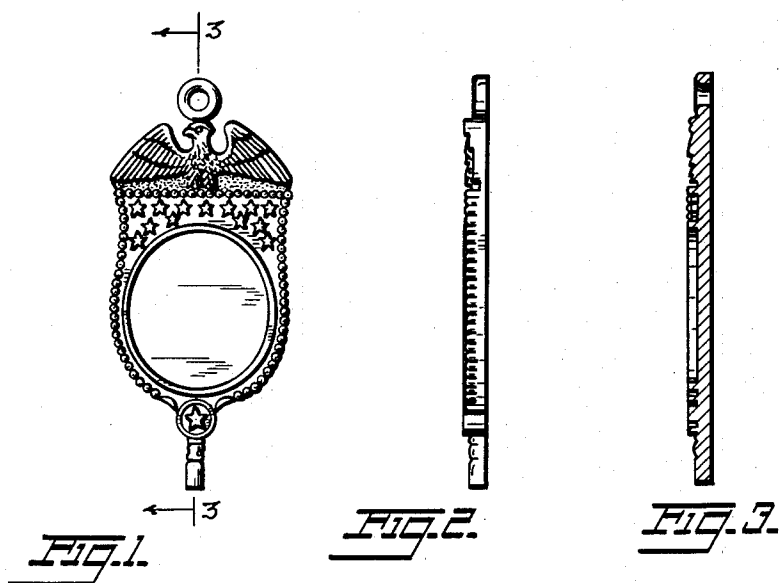

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Clarence M. Bradbury, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Key Pendant, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a face view of a key pendant, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same; and

Fig. 3 is a vertical section taken on the line 3—3 of Fig. 1.
