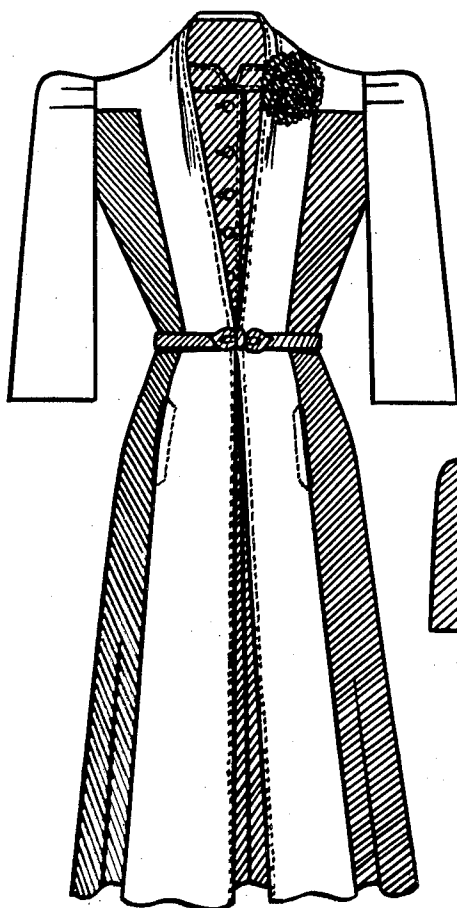

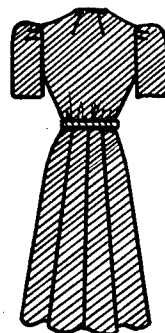

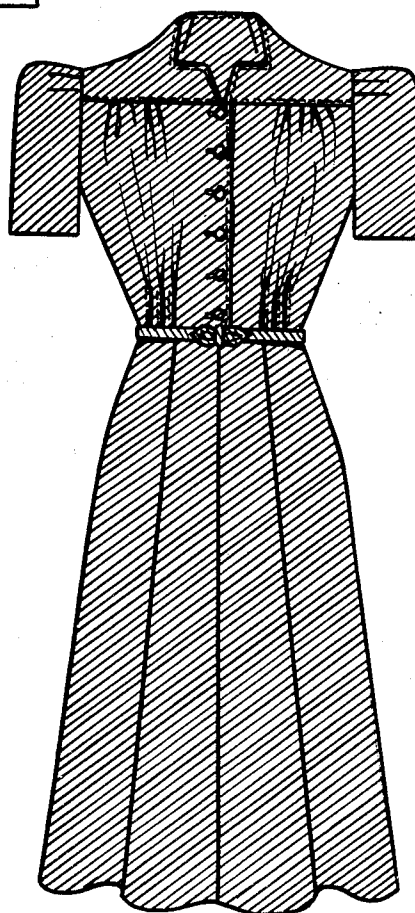

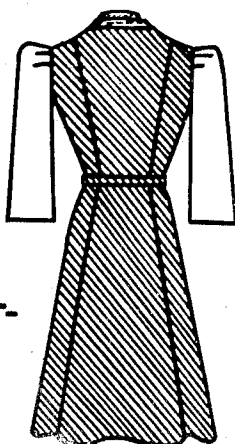

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Sol Richman, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress Ensemble, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein,

Figure 1 is a front view of a dress ensemble showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a front view of the dress unit of the dress ensemble shown in Figure 1.

Figure 3 is a rear view of the dress unit shown in Figure 2, drawn on a smaller scale.

Figure 4 is a rear view of the coat unit of the dress ensemble shown in Figure 1, drawn on a smaller scale.
