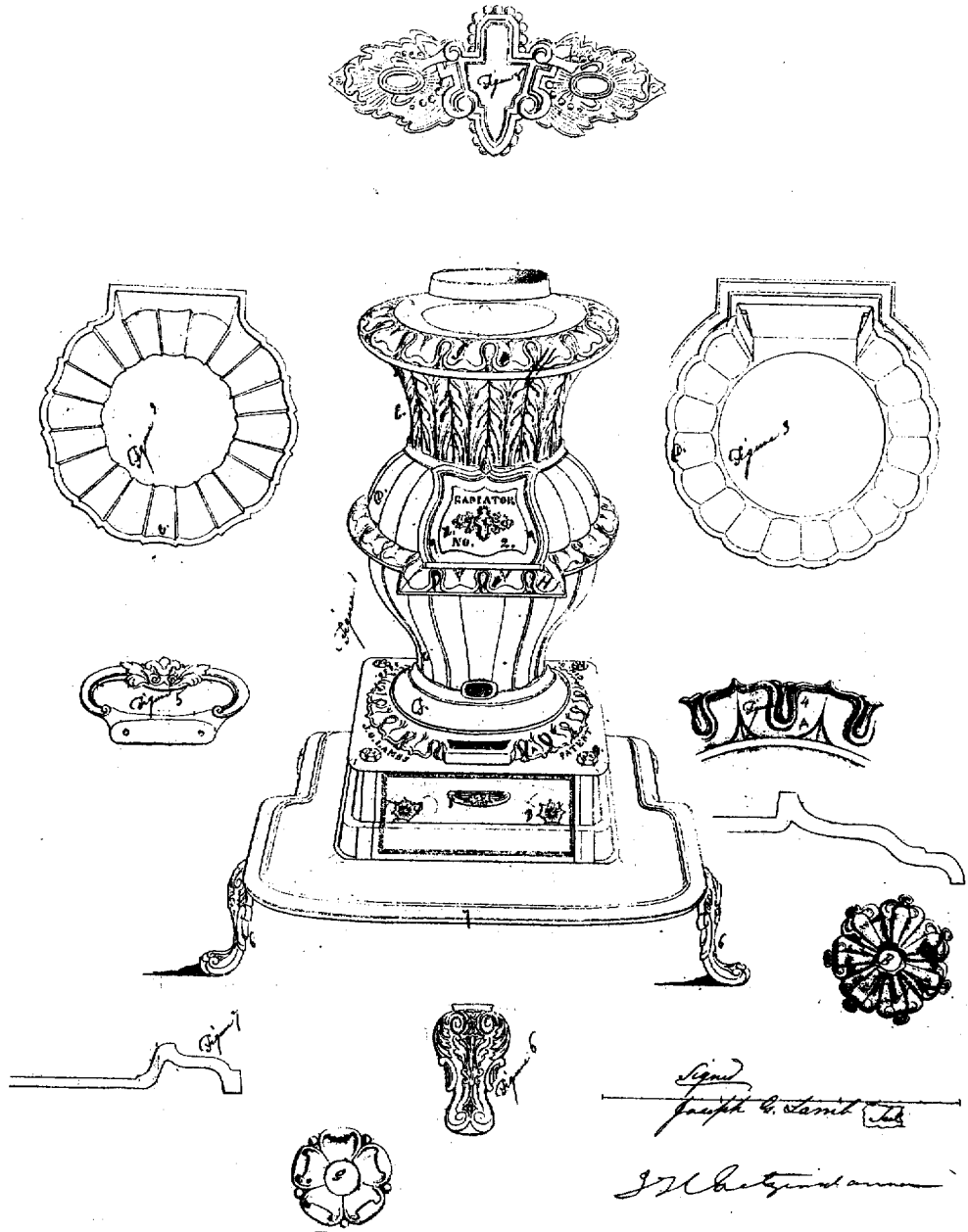

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that J. Joseph G. Lamb of Cincinnati, in the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new ornamental Design for Coal Heating Stoves, and I do hereby declare that the following is a full & exact description, & the annexed drawings a correct representation of the same. To wit. —

The large Drawing marked Figure 1. is a perspective view of the whole Stove, Figure 2, shows Lower Barrel cut through horizontally giving shape of flutes, Figure 3. shape of flutes on middle section of stove, Figure 4, ornamented A. moulding on top of ash box, H moulding around the center. I moulding on top of stove. Figure 5, is handle to ash box, Figure 6, Foot. Figure 7 is moulding around Bottom, Figure 8, ornament in center of Door. 4 section of moulding on box top.

B. B. ornaments on front of Ash Box - C. C. Lower Barrel - D. D. middle section - E. upper section carved with long leaves as shown. F. Ogee Base - G. four rollers on corners of Box top - I. Drop Door in front of Stove.

What I claim as new & my invention, is the combination & arrangement of the above described & represented shapes, figures, ornaments, flutes & mouldings into the above represented style & Design for Coal Heating Stoves, substantially as above shown. —
