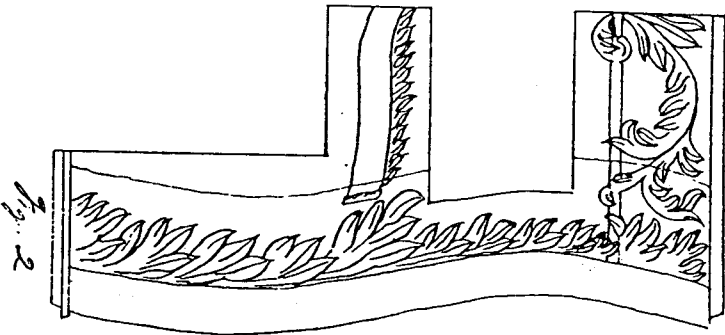
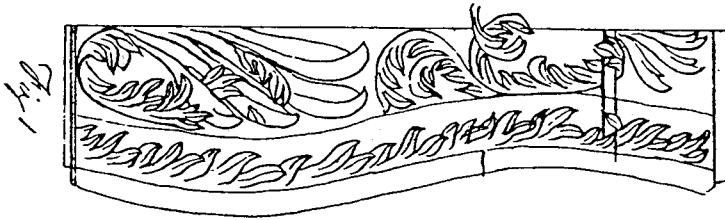

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The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern

Know ye that I Reuben J Blanchard of the City and County of Albany in the State of New York have invented or produced a new original and useful design for an ornament to be cast upon the cast iron plates of stoves, and I declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof reference being had to the annexed drawings which constitute a part of this specification.

Figure 1 in the drawings represents the half of the end plate of the Stove and figure 2 the half of the front plate, the remainder of each plate is similar and corresponding to that represented.

The ornament is in relief and consists -- vines and leaves as seen in the drawings. Upon the scroll in the front plate is the name of the maker, of the stove, which is omitted in the drawings as forming no part of the invented ornament.

What I claim as my invention and desire to <sup>secure</sup> by Letter Patent is the ornamental design for cast iron stove plates shown in the annexed drawings and above described. Dated July 10. 1857
