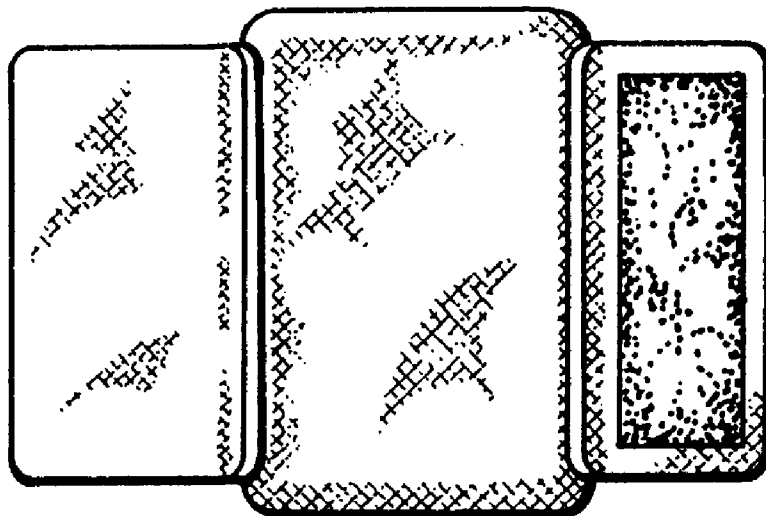
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for combined crutch armpit and hand support pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the combined crutch armpit and hand support pads showing my new design in use, the crutch shown in broken lines being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; the broken lines being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the hand support pad; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof from the bottom of FIG. 3; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof from the top of FIG. 3; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof from the left of FIG. 4; FIG. 8 is an opposite side elevational view from the right of FIG. 4. FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the armpit support pad; FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 11 front elevational view thereof from the bottom of FIG. 9; FIG. 12 is a side elevational view thereof from the top of FIG. 10; FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof from the top of FIG. 9; and, FIG. 14 is an opposite side elevational view thereof from the right of FIG. 10.

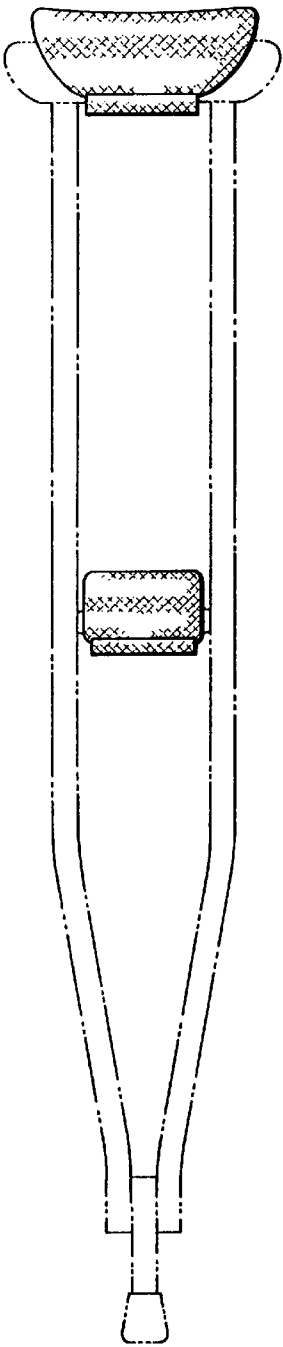

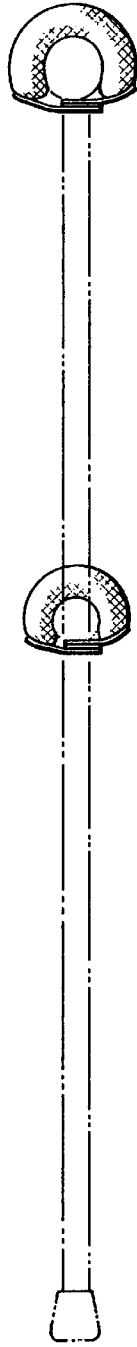

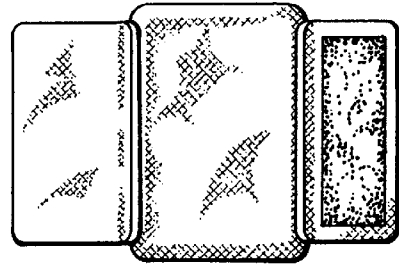

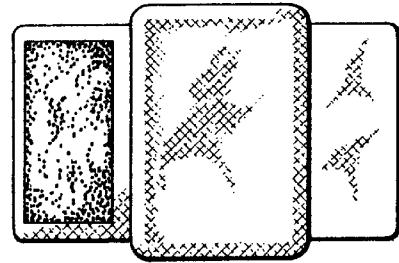

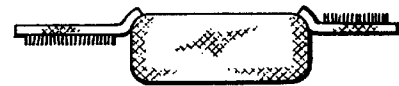

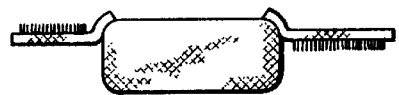

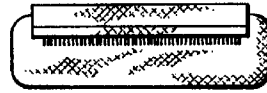

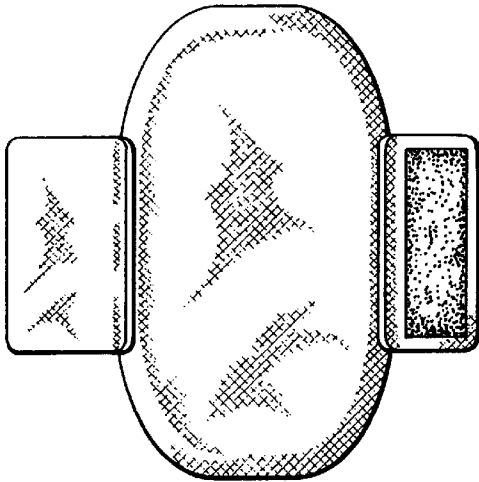

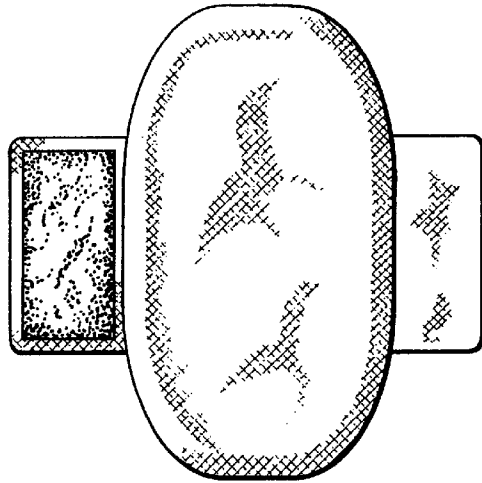

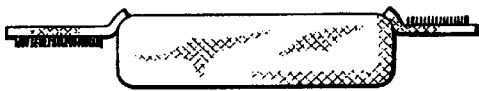

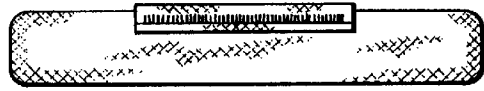

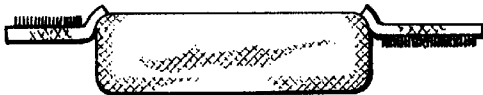
