(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foot exerciser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a foot exerciser, including a valve (shown in phantom) and a fastener member

(shown in phantom), in accordance with an embodiment of the present design, shown in an uninflated and an unworn condition;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the foot exerciser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the foot exerciser of FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the foot exerciser of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the foot exerciser of FIG. 2, the left side elevational view being a mirror image of the right side elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the foot exerciser of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the foot exerciser of FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the foot exerciser of FIGS. 1-7 in an inflated condition and worn about a foot (shown in phantom);

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the inflated foot exerciser of the FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the inflated foot exerciser of FIGS. 8 and 9;

FIG. 11 is a right side view of the inflated foot exerciser of FIGS. 8 and 9;


FIG. 12 is a left side view of the inflated foot exerciser of FIGS. 8 and 9; the left side elevational view being a mirror image of the right side elevational view

FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of the inflated foot exerciser of FIGS. 8 and 9; and,

FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view of the inflated foot exerciser of FIGS. 8 and 9.






















