


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Elmer Pandy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Clute, in the Province of Ontario, and Dominion of Canada, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Ash Tray, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
