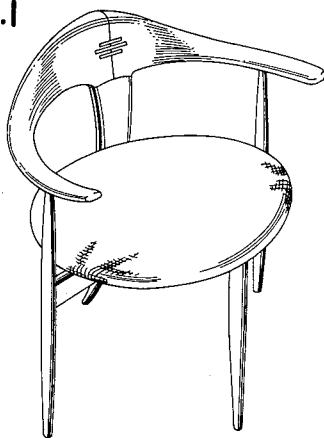

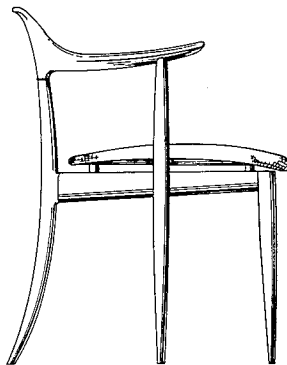

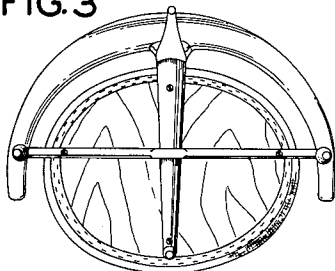

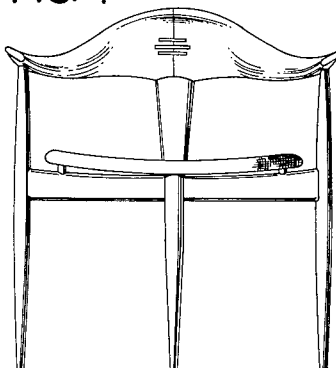

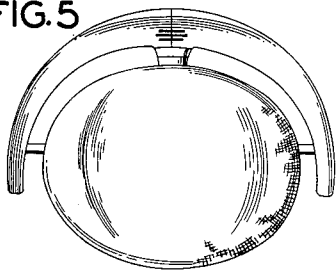


FIGURE 1 is a three-quarter front top perspective view of a chair showing our new design;
